We understand the importance of responsible sourcing and are dedicated to ensuring that our products do not contain conflict minerals, specifically tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold (3TG), sourced from areas of conflict or human rights abuses, particularly the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries.

We fully support the goals and objectives of Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, which requires companies to disclose their use of conflict minerals to ensure that they do not contribute to financing armed conflicts in the DRC or other affected regions.

HLH Rapid Limited has taken the following steps to support conflict-free sourcing:

- 1. Supplier Engagement:** We actively work with our suppliers to ensure that they source materials from responsible suppliers that do not support conflict-related activities. We expect our suppliers to comply with applicable laws, and provide relevant information regarding their sourcing practices.
- 2. Due Diligence:** We perform due diligence on our supply chain in accordance with the guidelines provided by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) for responsible mineral sourcing. This includes identifying the origin of the 3TG minerals used in our products and ensuring that they do not contribute to conflict.
- 3. Transparency and Reporting:** HLH Rapid Limited is committed to transparency in our supply chain and will provide information to our customers about the sourcing of 3TG minerals upon request. We work closely with our suppliers to verify the origin of minerals and ensure compliance with conflict mineral regulations.
- 4. Ongoing Commitment:** We continue to monitor and improve our conflict minerals program and are committed to supporting the global effort to prevent the use of conflict minerals.
